



Mission Mobile Patrol

Crime Prevention and Community Service Award

The Mission Mobile Patrol is comprised of 16 dedicated volunteers ranging in age from 19 to 70. The group is being recognized today for the extraordinary volunteer service that they provide to the residents of Mission.

The team works with District of Mission bylaw officers to deal with graffiti, vandalism and relocation of the homeless from makeshift camps to the community homeless shelter. They also support a variety of anti-auto theft programs and have been instrumental in assisting the Mission RCMP to identify and deal with uninsured vehicles on the road.

Mission Mobile Patrol regularly conducts patrols in areas where there is a history of reported property crime, deterring criminal activity and providing reassurance to the community at large.

The hardworking members of the Mission Mobile Patrol contributed over 2,800 hours of volunteer service in 2010 and are described by Mission's Crime Prevention Coordinator as "happy, enthusiastic, dedicated and sensitive to the needs of the community".
