



- Floodplain is the greyed area adjacent to the Fraser River and connected watercourses.
- Fraser River and connected watercourses are blue.
- Numbers along Fraser River are the 200 year flood elevations or dike design flood elevations in meters above sea level. These numbers include 0.6 meter of freeboard or extra height that is incorporated into dike design as a factor of safety, to protect against damage by floating debris and to allow a safe driving surface.

The floodplain limits are not established by legal survey. Flooding may still occur outside of the defined floodplain boundary and the District of Mission does not assume any liability by reason of failure to delineate floodplain areas on this map.
