GRANTS – MUNICIPAL GRANTS IN AID ASSISTANCE FOR NON-PROFIT LOW COST HOUSING

POLICY

Date Policy Adopted: May 22, 2001

Council Resolution Number:01/496

1. In order to provide financial assistance for non-profit low cost housing projects, Council may consider and provide a Grant in Aid to a registered non-profit society, to offset one or more of the following municipal fees:
 - a) amendments for Zoning or Official Community Plan designation
 - b) Development Permits or Development Variance Permits
 - c) municipal service installation
 - d) building permit
 - e) administration
 - f) municipal inspections
 - g) other applicable municipal fees
2. Applications for such grants may be submitted at any time during the year, and all applications will be forwarded directly to Council for review and decision.
3. Approved assistance will be based on unrealized revenue(s) and will be funded from Council's annual budget for "In Kind" grants.
4. Council's consideration and approval of such grants will be subject to:
 - a) applicant submitting a completed District of Mission Grant Application form
 - b) applicant providing specific details in regard to the use of the proposed grant funds
 - c) applicant providing proof of intent, at minimum, of matching contributions from other applicable levels of government
 - d) confirmation that membership on the Board of Directors of the proposed facility is not restricted to members of the sponsoring non-profit society
 - e) non-sectarian residency requirements
