Lace up your skates and join us for a variety of skating sessions that run September to April. Skate, cleat & helmet rentals available.

- **Public Skate** - All Ages
- **Discount Slow Paced Skate** - Half the ice at a discount price. All ages welcome - Adult/Senior \$2 & Children/Youth \$1
- **Youth Skate** - 12-18yrs
- **Parent & Child Hockey** - 3-8yrs
Foam pucks only.
- **Parent/Caregiver:** Helmet, gloves & stick.
- **Child:** Helmet with cage, gloves & stick.
- **Child Hockey** - 6-12yrs
Full gear required and non-contact.
- **Youth Hockey** - 13-18yrs
Full gear required and non-contact.
- **Adult Hockey** - 19+yrs
Full gear required and non-contact.
- **Stick & Puck Family** - Child/Youth (ages 3 - 18) with an adult.
- **Child/Youth:** full gear required.
- **Parent/Caregiver:** Helmet with cage, gloves and stick.

DROP-IN SKATING GUIDELINES

For your safety & enjoyment, please follow the guidelines:



Skates or cleats must be worn on the ice surface.



CSA approved helmets are recommended.



Strollers are permitted provided children are belted in a five point harness.



Hockey sticks or pucks are NOT PERMITTED.



Wear the supplied wristband and ensure it is visible.



Players benches and penalty boxes are OUT OF BOUNDS for skaters.



Report all injuries, accidents and concerns to Skate Patrol.



Follow the speed and direction of Skate Patrol.



All skaters must adhere to the Mission Leisure Centre Code of Conduct.



Ice Scooters are for beginner skaters.

- Please do not sit on them or play bumper cars, push people around or turn them on their sides.

Skate, Cleat & Helmet Rentals

The Mission Leisure Centre Skate Shop has skates, ice cleats and helmets available for rental during your drop-in skating session and lesson times. Please note, rental equipment is not available for Hockey sessions.

Sizes are limited so for busy drop-in sessions it is advised to come early.

Rentals Fees:

- Skates & Ice Cleats: \$4.00 Tax Included
- Helmets: \$1.00 Tax Included

Skate sharpening services are not available.

For safety reasons, the following actions are NOT permitted:

- skating too fast or backwards
- walking on the ice with shoes
- carrying children while skating
- inappropriate use of ice scooters
- throwing snow balls
- eating & drinking on the ice
- skating in chains
