

## Highlights of the Regular Council Meeting July 4, 2016

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### **Agricultural Land Commission Fees and Charges Update**

Land Use Application Procedures and Fees Bylaw 3612-2003 will be amended to reflect the Agricultural Land Commission's increased fees for exclusion, subdivision and non-farm use applications. The District will collect the new \$1500 fee and submit \$1200 of it to the Agricultural Land Commission.

### **Amendments to Water Rates Bylaw**

Water Rates Bylaw 2197-1990 will be amended to include key FOB fees in preparation for the upcoming installation of the new secured bulk water fill station at Mill Pond. The FOBs will be necessary to provide Mission residents, who are not connected to the municipal water supply, access to the water. Currently there will be no charge for withdrawing the potable water.

### **Advancement of Funding for New Water Source Supply Preliminary Investigation**

Council resolved that \$24,320, (Mission's 12.16% share of \$200,000 regional total) be transferred from the existing 2016 Regional Water Capital Program Contingency budget to be used for a preliminary investigation of new water source options. This advancement of funding was authorized by the Abbotsford Mission Water & Sewer Commission.
