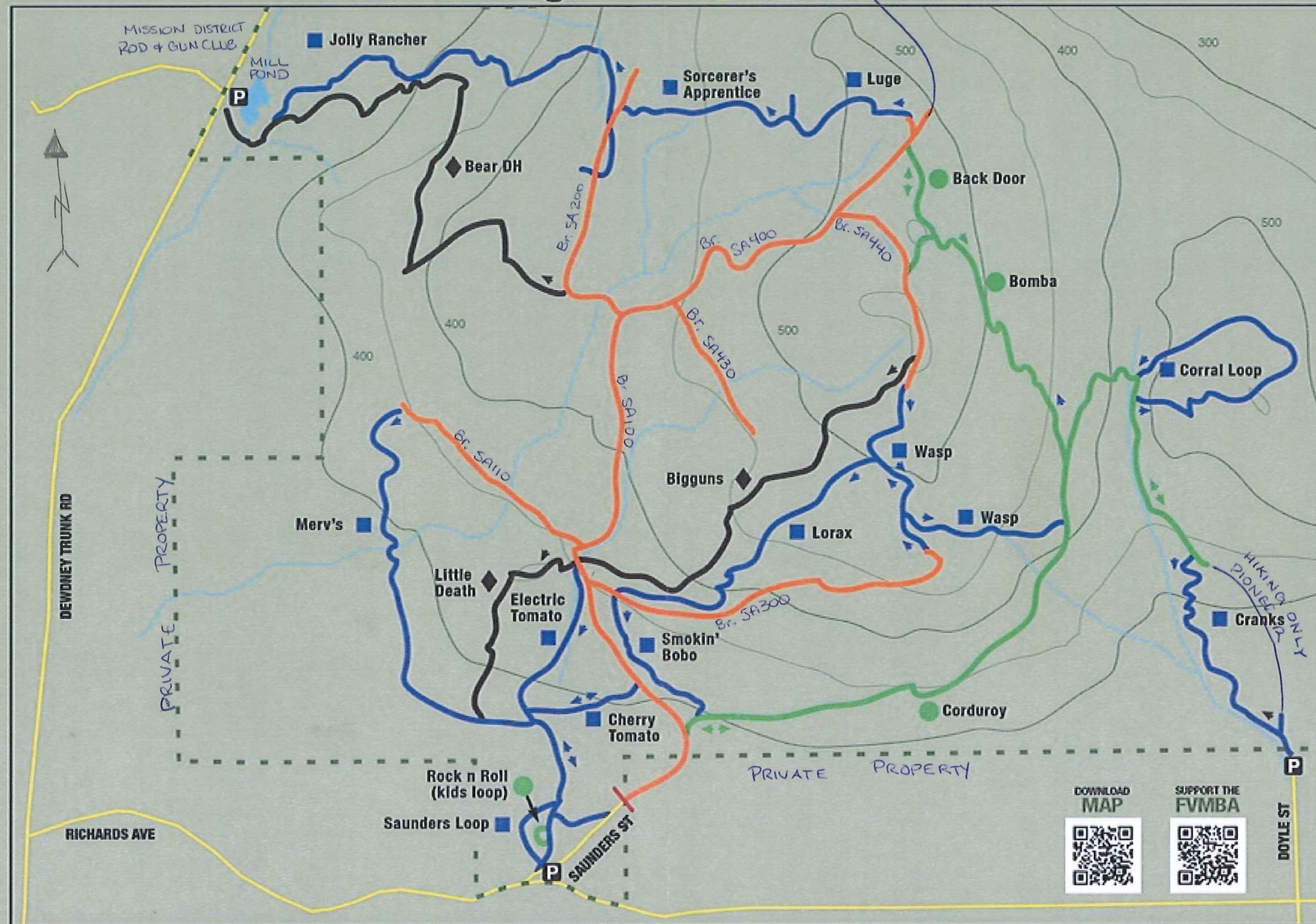


BEAR MOUNTAIN

All recreation trails shown are for non-motorized use only. Please keep horses to logging roads (access to Bear mt via Saunders St and to Red mt via the Bypass Trail on the west side of Dewdney Trunk Rd), and respect the countless volunteers hours provided by the FVABA on the majority of trails.

- Multi-use - Anticipate others and slow down on all corners - Use courtesy
- Stay off trails during wet/muddy conditions and avoid shortcutting to prevent erosion.
- Expect natural conditions, loose rocks, exposed roots, wooden bridges may be slippery, and windfall could be across trails at any time.
- Report maintenance items promptly to 604-810-3162.

The recreation trails shown are maintained by a cooperative agreement between the District of Mission, Recreation Sites and Trails BC and the Fraser Valley Mountain Bikers Association.
