BY-LAW NO. 1033-1981.

A By-law to declare the Mission Museum
as a Municipal Heritage Building.

WHEREAS the Heritage Conservation Act, Part 111, permits Council to designate land and buildings as a Municipal Heritage Site, and;

WHEREAS Council has given notice pursuant to Section 11 of the Heritage Conservation Act of its intention to consider passing this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Mission, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "District of Mission Museum Municipal Heritage Building By-law No. 1033-1981".
2. The building located at 33201-2nd Avenue in the District of Mission, upon land more particularly described as Lot B of Blocks 79 and 80, District Lot 411, Group 1, Plan 1900 (with By-law filed No. 41164), New Westminster District, is hereby designated as a Municipal Heritage Building.

READ A SECOND TIME this 1st day of June, 1981.

READ A THIRD TIME this 1st day of June, 1981.
