A Bylaw to declare the Mission Memorial Centre  
Society Building as a Municipal Heritage Building

WHEREAS the Heritage Conservation Act, Part III, permits Council to designate land and buildings as a Municipal Heritage Site, and;

WHEREAS Council has given notice pursuant to Section 22 of the Heritage Conservation Act of its intention to consider passing this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Mission, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "District of Mission Heritage Building (Mission Memorial Centre) Bylaw No. 1718-1987".
2. The building located at 33070 - 5th Avenue in the District of Mission, and legally described as Lot 518, Block 17, Plan 51424, Section 21, Township 17, L.D. 36, N.W. Lease, is hereby designated as a Municipal Heritage Building.

READ A SECOND TIME this 30th day of November, 1987.


READ A THIRD TIME this 30th day of November, 1987.
