

**DISTRICT OF MISSION**

**BYLAW 3704-2004**

**A Bylaw to declare Silverhill Hall as a Municipal Heritage Building**

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Local Government Act*, Council may designate land and buildings as a Municipal Heritage Site, and;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Mission, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "District of Mission Heritage Building (Silverhill Hall) Bylaw 3704-2004".
2. The log construction portion of the building located at 31016 Silverhill Avenue, and legally described as Parcel Identifier: 010-682-911 Parcel "A" (Plan with Fee Deposited 25896E) Lot 5, Section 36, Township 14, New Westminster District Plan 2687 and identified in cross hatch on Schedule A attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, is designated as a heritage building.
3. The owner(s) of the building may alter the exterior of the building or make structural changes to the interior of the building, all in order to improve the structural integrity of the building, without first obtaining a heritage alteration permit.
