Farmers' Appreciation Week

September 8 to 15, 2013 has been proclaimed as "Farmers' Appreciation Week" in celebration of BC's farmers, agriculture and food. Farmers make up only 1.5% of BC's population, yet produce approximately 48% of all foods consumed in BC.

Public Hearing for 32588 and 32688 Cedar Valley Connector

Zoning Amending Bylaw 5370-2013-5050(114) received third reading after the public hearing in a 4:2 vote. Final approval is subject to the developer meeting a number of requirements. This bylaw will allow for a mix of housing options on the properties including single family detached dwellings and row houses.

Appointment to Fraser House Society Board

Mayor Adlem has been appointed as the Council liaison to the Fraser House Society Board of Directors.

Waste Reduction Week

Development Application for 8448 and 8462 Stave Lake Street

First readings have been granted to bylaws that propose to amend the Official Community Plan and rezone the above properties to allow for 24 front-loaded row houses (garages in the front) and 4 single family residential lots. The proposed subdivision plan has been designed to fit with other proposed development in the immediately surrounding area. The development proposal for the above properties will move forward to a Public Hearing on September 23.
