Fraser Valley Watersheds Coalition

Promote Healthy Watersheds and Healthy Communities across the Fraser Valley and they are in process of organizing the Stave River Tidal Channels - Salmon Habitat Restoration. They encourage the community to watch their website for dates in September to assist in replanting this area and learning more about this project and the need for healthy watersheds.

Non-Permitted Uses at 34201 Laxton Avenue

The owners of 34201 Laxton Avenue are directed to cease allowing all nuisances that are in non-compliance with the District of Mission Bylaws. Additionally, staff have been authorized to proceed, as deemed necessary, with civil injunction, including cost recovery, to stop the non-permitted uses at this address.

Appointment of Approving Officer

With the departure of Sharon Fletcher, Director of Long Range Planning, the District has appointed the new Director of Engineering and Public Works, Tracy Kyle as the new Approving Officer for the District of Mission pursuant to Section 77(1) of the *Land Titles Act*.

Quarterly Financial Reporting – June 30, 2014

Council has asked staff to continue to closely monitor their spending and revenues for the remainder of the year.

Design and Operating Plan and Abbotsford Curbside Waste

That the waste management utility capital budget to update the Mission Landfill Design and Operating Plan be increased. Further it will include a cost-benefit analysis and long-term implications of the possibility of accepting all or part of Abbotsford's curbside refuse for disposal at no extra cost to the District of Mission.
