

Highlights of the Regular Council Meeting April 20, 2015

Water Meter Pilot Study

A water meter pilot study to examine water consumption in a diverse sample of single family homes will begin in summer 2015 and continue through to summer 2016. Upon completion, the District will have a more accurate estimate of the per capita water use.

Missing Children's Month and Day

Council has proclaimed May as "Missing Children's Month" and May 25, 2015 as "Missing Children's Day" in support of Child Find BC and its mandate to educate children and adults about abduction prevention, to promote awareness of the problem of missing children, and to assist in the location of missing children.

Permitted Uses in the Downtown Core

As part of the MissionCity Downtown Action Plan, Council is considering removing some permitted uses for businesses in the downtown area. District staff, in conjunction with the Downtown Business Association, will be undertaking an informal poll of downtown businesses and the public to determine what specific uses are preferable or undesirable for downtown businesses.

Mental Health Week

Centennial Place and the Mission Mental Health Advisory Committee are hosting an annual **Walk for Wellness Rally** event on **May 6** at 11:00 am at Mission Hills Mall. In recognition of community inclusion, May 4 to 10 has been proclaimed as "Mental Health Week" in Mission.

Council has proclaimed May 1 to 7 as "Youth Week", an international celebration to recognize youth and foster a strong connection between young people and their communities. **Youth Fest** will take place on **May 2** from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Mission Leisure Centre.
