

Highlights of the Regular Council Meeting November 2, 2015

Cedar Street and 7th Avenue Intersection Improvements – Item deferred

Discussion on the planned improvements to the intersection at 7th Avenue and Cedar Street was deferred to the November 16, 2015 Regular Council Meeting.

Heritage Park Observatory Project

Council passed a motion to formalize the decision to discontinue the observatory project at Fraser River Heritage Park. The District will be seeking public input for recommendations on the future of the observatory building.

Change of Hours for Sisto's Pub

Council has provided support for an application from Sisto's Pub to the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch to extend their hours of operation on Saturdays and Sundays by opening at 9:00 a.m. instead of 11:00 a.m.

Asset Management Planning Program Grant

The Ministry of Community, Sport and Cultural Development offers grant funding to local governments to assist with asset management planning and practices. District staff will be submitting an application for a matching grant of up to \$10,000 for 2016, and will be reporting back to Council on the results and any required commitments.

A Day for Our Common Future

December 11, 2015 has been proclaimed as "A Day for Our Common Future" within the District of Mission.

Landfill Contract Extension

The contract for operation and maintenance of Minnie's Pit Landfill with SSG Holdings Ltd. has been extended for a period of one year to allow sufficient time to determine additional services that should be included in the next contract.
