

DISTRICT OF MISSION - **SUMMARY OF A MEETING**

Summary of a **meeting** held Bellevue Hotel on June 16, 2009 commencing at 6:30 p.m. between District of Mission Council and the Downtown Business Association (DBA) Directors.

On June 16, 2009 members of council were invited to a Downtown Business Association (DBA) meeting to discuss issues of relevance to the DBA. The items that were discussed are noted in the attached agenda for the meeting.

The first item discussed was the downtown security issue and municipal staff informed the DBA members that council had approved a spending package to provide for security in the downtown area. It was agreed that staff would provide a copy of the spending package to the president of the DBA and that the Director of Corporate Administration would also contact Steve Yap to outline the proposed scope of the security arrangements. A discussion ensued about the use of ambassador programs in other communities and there was a suggestion by the DBA that the security funding could be integrated with some form of an ambassador program.

The second item for discussion was the district goals for 2009-2011. Municipal staff reviewed the municipal goals relative to the downtown providing an explanation of each of the individual goals.

The third item for discussion was the proposed Translink funding to upgrade the Westcoast Express station to accommodate larger trains. Municipal staff explained that this was a project to accommodate longer trains that would be needed during the Olympics and that it was not related to overall improvements to transportation circulation other than the platform extensions. DBA representatives questioned if the funding was linked to the upgrade or relocation of the bus exchange in the downtown and it was noted that while the bus exchange was a current discussion item before council the Translink funding was not in any way related. It was agreed that the Director of Engineering and Public Works would provide information that was available on the platform extensions to the DBA Executive Directors.

The final item discussed was an expansion of the DBA boundaries. It was noted that over time there may be requests to expand the area boundaries for the existing DBA area. It was agreed that there was a distinction between the DBA boundaries for the purpose of the taxation bylaw and the general concept that the greater downtown area encompassed the area below 7th Avenue through to the waterfront.

Closing comments were provided by the chair of the DBA and Mayor Atebe and the meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
