## MAIL BALLOT VOTING

For this by-election, ALL eligible voters have the opportunity to cast their vote by mail.

All requests for a mail ballot package must be received no later than **4:00 pm on April 22, 2021**. You can request a package by:

- completing the online request form at [mission.ca/elections](https://mission.ca/elections) or
- telephoning Election Headquarters at **604-820-3705**

Mail ballot packages will be sent out by mail commencing on or about April 1, 2021.

*\*\*Packages requested after 4:00 pm on April 9, 2021 must be picked up at Mission Municipal Hall, 8645 Stave Lake Street. The deadline to pick up a mail ballot package is 4:00 pm on April 23, 2021.*

The completed ballots may be mailed in the envelope provided or dropped off at Mission Municipal Hall (8645 Stave Lake Street) using the secure drop box on the north side of the building.

To be counted for the by-election, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer **no later than 8:00 pm on April 24, 2021**.

It is the responsibility of the elector to return the ballot by this deadline.

## ELECTOR REGISTRATION

**If you are not on the list of electors**, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the District of Mission for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

**To register, resident electors** must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity. Examples of acceptable identification are listed on the Election page of [mission.ca](https://mission.ca)

Individuals who would like **to register as a non-resident property elector** must obtain an elector certificate from the Chief Election Officer at Mission Municipal Hall during regular business hours prior to 4:30 pm on Friday, April 23, 2021 or on advance and general voting days during voting hours. To register you must provide **two** pieces of identification containing your name and address, at least one with your signature, and complete an ***Application for Registration as a Non-Resident Property Elector***. If more than one person is registered as an owner on the property, a ***Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Form*** is required as written consent from the majority of the registered owners appointing ONE of the registered owners as the non-resident property elector for the property.
