The following procedures for voting and for conducting voting proceedings apply to the special voting opportunities:

The ballot boxes and necessary supplies for the voting may be carried from room to room by the presiding election official and another election official to afford each elector the opportunity to vote at his/her bedside, where it is determined by the presiding election official that the elector cannot attend the voting place established at each of the special voting opportunities.

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the District of Mission for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

To register, resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity. Examples of acceptable identification is listed on the Election page of mission.ca

Individuals who would like **to register as a non-resident property elector** must obtain an elector certificate from the Chief Election Officer at Mission Municipal Hall during regular business hours prior to 4:30 pm on Friday, October 19, 2018 and on advance and general voting days during voting hours. To register you must provide **two** pieces of identification containing your name and address, at least one with your signature, and complete an ***Application for Registration as a Non-Resident Property Elector***. If more than one person is registered as an owner on the property, a ***Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Form*** is required as written consent from the majority of the registered owners appointing ONE of the registered owners as the non-resident property elector for the property.
