

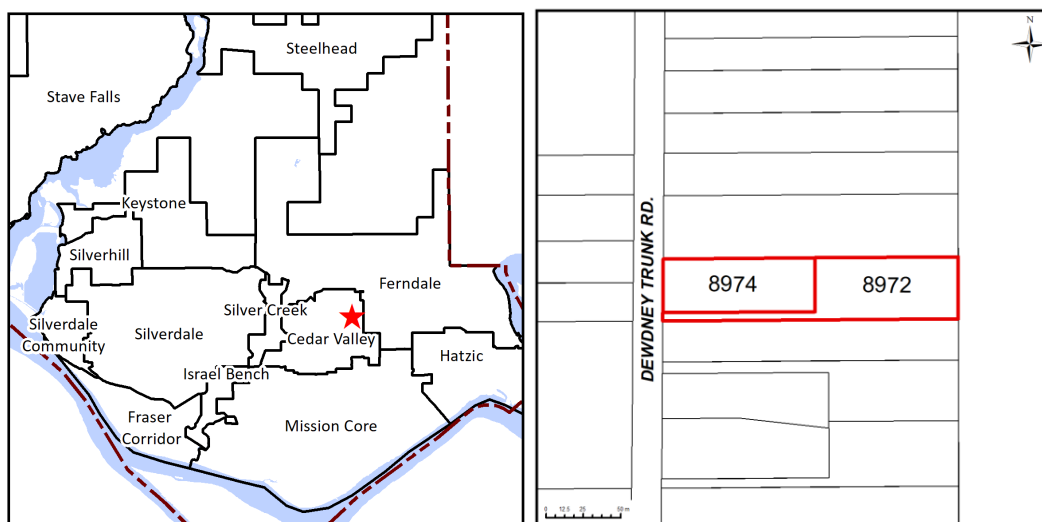
**DISTRICT OF MISSION
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 464 and 466 of the *Local Government Act*, a Public Hearing will take place in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Hall, 8645 Stave Lake Street, Mission, BC at **6:00 pm on Tuesday, May 21, 2019** to consider the following proposed bylaw:

1. **DISTRICT OF MISSION LAND USE CONTRACT REPEAL BYLAW 5834-2019**
(LUC18-015 – District of Mission)

The purpose of the Bylaw is to discharge Land Use Contract No. 593-1977 registered to the properties located at **8972 & 8974 Dewdney Trunk Road** (shown on the maps below).

Note: There are no proposed changes to the existing buildings or land use. Discharging the Land Use Contract Bylaw No. 593-1977 will allow the underlying Rural Residential (RR7) Zone to come into effect one year after Final Adoption of the Land Use Contract Repeal Bylaw.



Copies of the proposed bylaw and report relevant to this bylaw may be inspected at the Municipal Hall, 8645 Stave Lake Street, Mission, BC, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays, from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, from Friday, May 10, 2019 to Tuesday, May 21, 2019.
