This procedure deals with allocation of resources to deal with brine pretreatment on public roads. In general terms, the District is divided into seven zones. These zones have been detailed on sketch plans and indicate priority routes #1 and #2 on each plan. Priority routes #3 entail all other roads in each area zone, with the exception of lanes, which will not be plowed, as detailed in Snow Plowing Procedure STR.24. Through the original developmental phases of brine pretreatment, only priority #1 routes will receive brine applications.

For the purposes of this procedure, with the intent of further development to aid the snow and ice removal program, the Roads and Drainage Foreman or his/her designate will dispatch units for roadway pretreatment as follows:

1. Unit # 5174 will provide first response from the public works yard along Dewdney Trunk Road to the west boundary, then working back completing snow routes 7, 6, 5 and 3 priority #1 routes.
2. Unit # 5156 will provide pretreatment to priority #1 routes in snow routes 1, 2 and 4.
3. Unit # 5162 will provide pretreatment to transit routes.

In the event of a mechanical failure or incident that would force any of the above numbered vehicles from service, adjustments will be made including the possible cancelling of the pretreatment and completing preparations for Snow Plowing Procedure STR.24.
