ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS The Canadian Forces is tasked by the Canadian People and Parliament to protect Canadians and Canadian interests at home and overseas, and

WHEREAS the members of the Canadian Forces Reserve Force play a vital and essential role in this ever-more important task, and

WHEREAS in British Columbia some two thousand five hundred and eighty men and women are serving in the Reserve Force in their local communities and on domestic and international operations, and

WHEREAS the members of the Reserve Force make a significant contribution through their dedication to their families, communities, British Columbia and Canada, and

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002.

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that December 1, 2011 shall be known as

“RESERVE FORCE DAY”

in the Province of British Columbia.

Subject: Rezoning Application R11-009 (MASH) – 32821 and 32835 Janzen Avenue and 8352 Cedar Street

The subject property went to Public Hearing on July 25, 2011 and the public hearing minutes have been finalized. At the July 25, 2011 Council Meeting, Council gave third reading to Official Community Plan Amending Bylaw 5222-2011-4052(14) and Zoning Amending Bylaw 5223-2011-5050(44). The applicant is Mission Association for Seniors' Housing and the proposal is for a 42 unit seniors' apartment. The applicant has now met all the conditions for final reading for the bylaws:

- Engineering Requirements have been met.
- Fire Department comments have been received and they support the access for this development.
- The easement for access between MASH and the Cedar Valley Mennonite Church and the right-of-way for pedestrian access to Griner Park are ready for registration.
- An undertaking from the applicant's solicitor to register all the applicable plans and documents (easement, rights-of-way) has been received.

Please note that the road closure bylaw 5212-2011 (Janzen Avenue) was adopted on October 17, 2011 and the road closure and lot consolidation plans are ready for filing at the Land Title Office. All the plans and documents will be submitted to the Land Title Office for registration by the applicant's solicitor following the rezoning.

Accordingly, Official Community Plan Amending Bylaw 5222-2011-4052(14) and Zoning Amending Bylaw 5223-2011-5050(44) are listed in the Bylaws Section of the agenda for Council's consideration of adoption.



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
